Australian championship draw released

The draw for the 2020 Australian Pipe Band Championships – celebrating the Diamond Jubilee year of Pipe Bands Australia – has been released this evening.

The two-day championships will be hosted by Maryborough Highland Society for the second time in the event's history. The society hosted the first championships in 1961.

The draw has been prepared by championships host, Pipe Bands Victoria, and endorsed by Pipe Bands Australia.

A street march of all competing bands on Saturday 4 April will open the weekend from 9.30am down High St Maryborough to Princes Park where the music events will be conducted.

Included in the draw are details of street march assembly, the massed band performances on each day of the championships, information on associated events over the weekend and additional notes to assist competing bands.

Maryborough Highland Society will issue further newsletters to competing bands in the lead-up to the championships.
