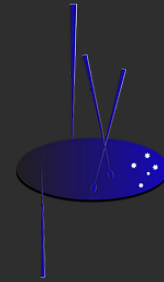

Next in series of review conversations

The next dates in a series of forums around Australia in the national conversation as part of the Pipe Bands Australia review process have been announced following the first forums conducted in Canberra last weekend.

They are:

- Additional forum dates and locations, including regional venues, will be announced shortly.

The survey launched week, forums and submissions will assist the review panel in gathering information and ideas from members ahead of formulating draft options for a Green Paper to be released in December.

The review follows the decision of national council at its biennial conference last September to investigate future options for the structure of Pipe Bands Australia and its core activities.

Members of the review panel – Jamie Forsyth, Richard Wilson, Chris Swan, Athol Chalmers and Chris Earl – are engaging with members, bands and branches as part of the national conversation.
